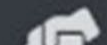

LOBBY - Lists current attendees in a session. Search attendee by name or company and connect directly.

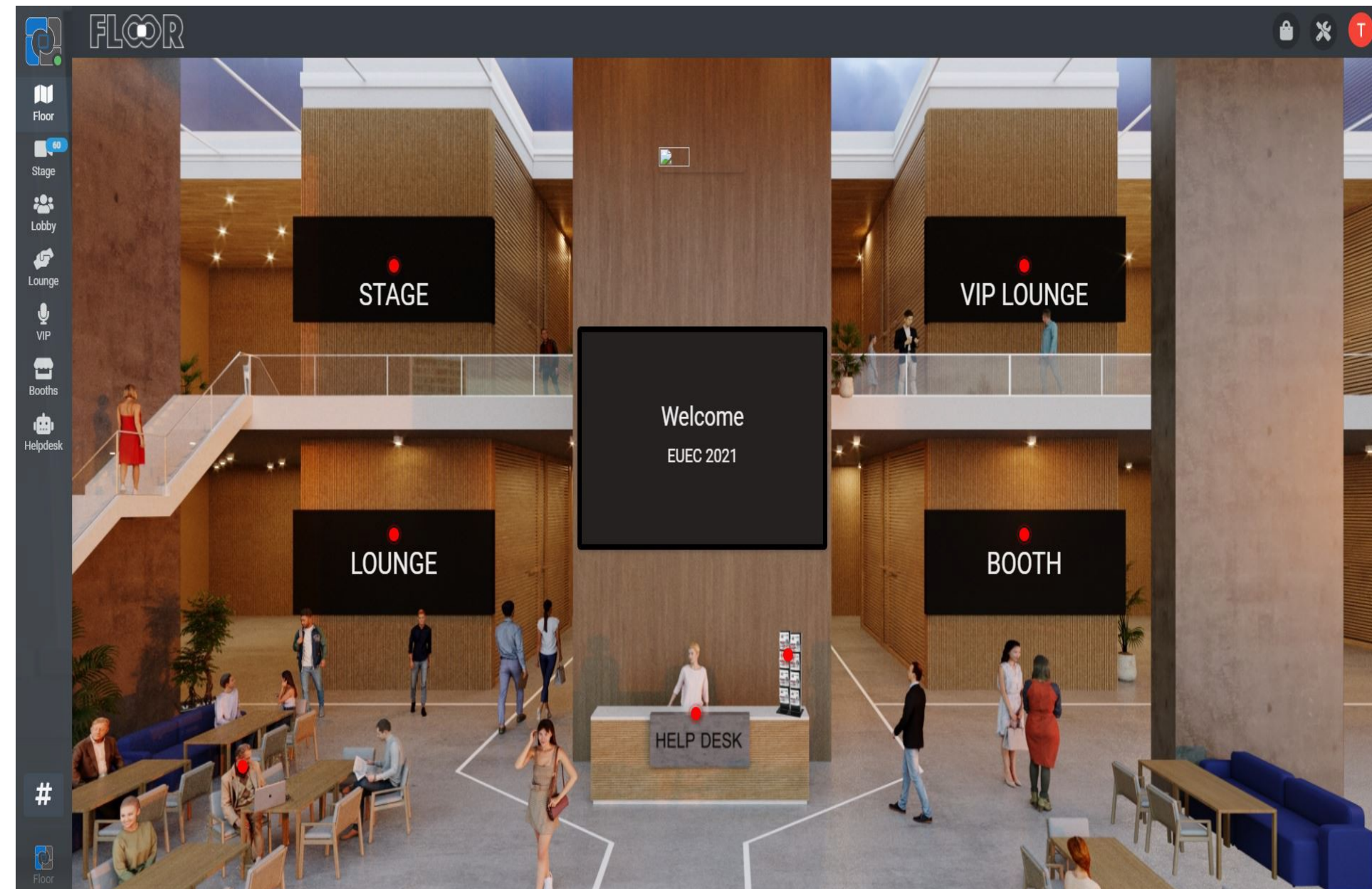
LOUNGE - Shows the 70 tables with exhibitor logos and 4 chairs available for you to "Grab a seat", to chat and meet live with staff.
